

## **CLOUD KINGS CLUB MEETING – June 12, 2007**

21 members in attendance

Two officers Bill Losey and John Anderson were present.

The meeting was originally cancelled by email so some members were not present.

The decision was made to have a meeting since so many members had shown up.

### **Show and Tell:**

There were no subjects or items brought up for show and tell.

### **Old Business:**

- Bill suggested that members try to come out on Wednesdays, starting on the 13<sup>th</sup> to Harris field for an evening of flying. We want to give Walt the impression that we are still interested in Harris Field other than for funfly activities.
- Club Fun Fly June 23<sup>rd</sup> Rain Date 24<sup>th</sup> was discussed. See notes below.
  - Members should be at field by 9:00 to help setup and to be assigned jobs for the day.
  - Food available by 10:00 to 10:30
  - Alpha Squadron Show Team will be coming
- Discussion on the RC Vintage Event at West Field on October 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>
  - Open to the public and club members
  - Vintage flying only on Saturday
    - No club use of West Field for regular flying on Saturday
    - We will open Harris Field on this weekend for the club
    - Open flying on Sunday for all aircraft types
  - Bob Fling will be the Club Sponsor at this event along with Mike Denest
  - Cloud Kings might do a 50/50 at the event
- Talked briefly about neighbor complaint of last week
  - The complaint was caused by excessive flying in the valley at the entrance to the field. Remember to keep out of this area except for takeoff and landing activities.

### **New Business**

- John Anderson raised a discussion on making it easier for members to join, especially for any prospective members that we pick up at the Fun-Fly. The Decision was to leave the new membership process alone at this time since we already have an extra July meeting to accelerate the membership process in the summer.
- We will be adding 4 or more pilot flight markers at West Field. A pilot will be required to stand in this area in-order to fly. Remember that only four aircraft are allowed in the air at one time.

- Update on Club Plane given by John Anderson. Still need 5 standard servos.
- Bill Losey brought up the issue of pets being brought to flying field based on an email from Dick Plyler. There was a lively discussion of this issue as it is perceived to be a safety issue. A vote was taken on whether to ban pets. The vote was 12 Yes, 4 No, 5 Abstain.  
The club decision was to ask members not to bring their pets to the field.
