Airplane Talk

Bill Hyde talked about a plane called the Facet Mobile. It is named that because of the many flat sides to the plane. The real Facet Mobile weighs 740 pounds and first flew in 1993. It then flew from California to the EAA Bash in Osh Kosh Wisconsin. The plane is 20 foot long, 15 foot wide and is powered by a 46 hp Rotax. Henry Bohe reported that there are several Gremlins flying in the club. This is the plane that will be used for the club combat contest. A .23-.32 glow engine powers it. Henry had copies of an article about the Gremlin to give to anyone interested.

Bill Losey brought in a Multiplex Easy Star. It is constructed of foam, which can be glued with regular CA glue. The plane comes with the motor. The plane costs about \$57. The motor draws maximum 7 amps with a 5 x 3 prop. With the battery that Bill uses the motor is delivering 62 watts of power. He can get approximately one hour of flight time with his battery. Bill Hyde has the same plane, but his motor (after market installation) is producing 110 watts of power.

Louis Kinney brought in two "Foamies". Louis soloed this summer with the help of Dale Adams and all the flight instructors. Henry Belifore gave him a wrecked foamie, which he repaired and practices 3D maneuvers. It has crashed and been repaired many times. Louis bought a new plane for about \$39. The motor was purchased at BP Hobbies. He uses a 2 cell 750 mAh Li-Poly battery. This gives him a 7-10 minute flight depending on how he uses the motor. The new plane has about 8 flights on it. Hinge tape is used for the hinges.

Ernie Smith brought in a DeHavilland Vampire. It is powered with a small brushless motor. The plane is built from balsa wood. It weighs about 7-1/2 ounces. The motor is a Little Screamer motor. Has not flown yet.
