As I see it, one of our most pressing needs is the training and qualifying of our non-flying members, both old and new, to solo and fly safely. This is no simple task because it takes the willingness and time of our more experienced members to sponsor and instruct all those who want to learn.

The club leaders are working hard to address this issue by recruiting instructors, establishing standards and getting students assigned to instructors. We have identified a list of potential instructors and have agreed to a set of basic requirements to qualify a student to solo a fixed-wing aircraft. By "solo" we mean be qualified to fly alone without an instructor present.

Pre-Flight

Use of frequency pin and range checking
Aircraft integrity and inspection
Control surface check (movement and direction)
Proper engine start-up and adjustment
Active runway direction and priorities
Announcing your intentions

Flying

Taxi to takeoff position and hold
Takeoff and fly the landing pattern
Fly a horizontal figure "8"
Handle and engine-out situation
Three takeoff and full-stop landings with engine running
Taxi to side of active runway
Proper shutdown and frequency pin return

You must demonstrate the above proficiency in order to become a solo flyer.

In closing, I would like to ask that you plan to join us at our Christmas Dinner on December 16th at the Red Rose Inn in Jennersville. The cost will be around \$25 per person. Until then, see you at the field!
