As sunny and warm the Buy and Fly was, Octoberfest was just the opposite.

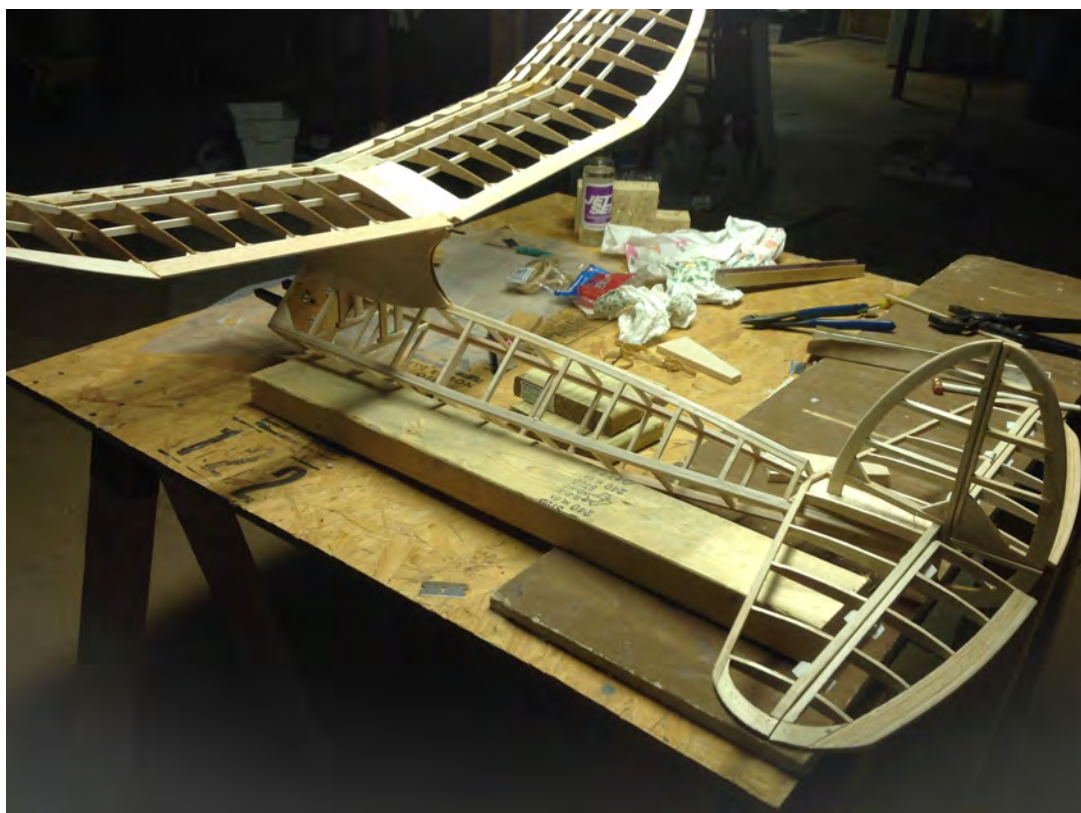

He started building it in early August and took about 3 1/2 weeks to build and cover it. It is powered by a Turnigy G46 Brushless Outrunner 670kv with a 15" X 6 prop and a 4 cell 5000 ma and a 70amp ESC. It's first flight was on 09/17/14 and it was test flown by Bill Brueckman.
